"Way to Heaven" is the story of a fictitious model town, constructed by the Germans in 1941 and populated by Jewish prisoners. With the town, German authorities sought to convince visiting Red Cross investigators of the humaneness of the concentration camps. In the play, we follow one of these young investigators as he confronts the town's citizens, the Nazi commandant, and, finally, himself.
